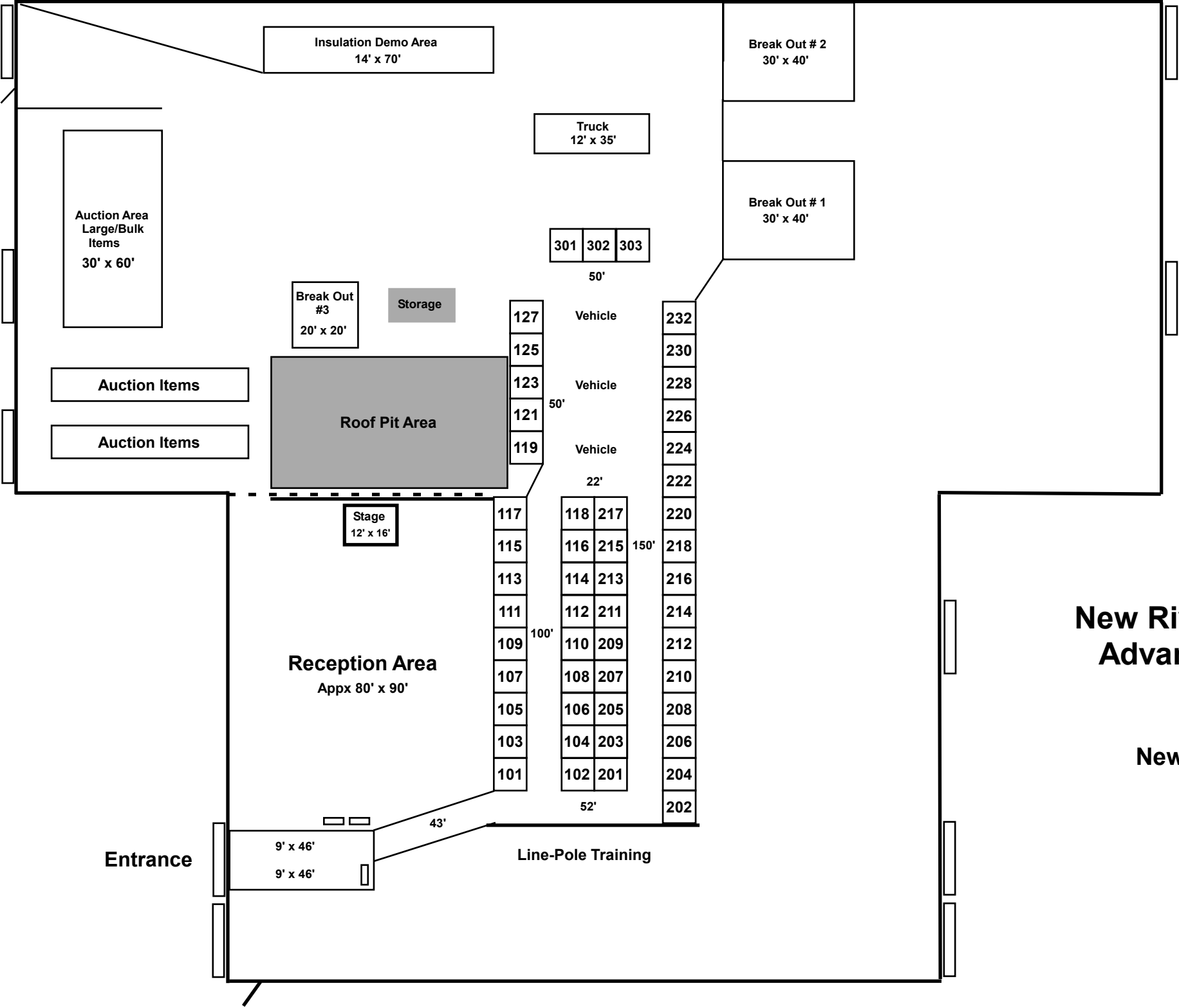

## EXHIBIT SPACE

Standard booths are 10' wide by 10' deep and come with an 8' draped back wall and 3' side rails unless noted differently in your sponsorship agreement. Platinum sponsors receive a 10'x30' booth, gold and silver sponsors receive a 10'x20' booth. All booths include a 6' skirted table, two chairs and electrical hook-up. If you require carpet additional tables/chairs, furniture, or audio visual rental, we recommend you contact Kris Peter from Hollins Exposition Services at 540.362.5490, ext. 115. Please refer to the attached floor plan for the event. Individual booth spaces will be assigned by October 23, 2010.
